

## **Regional Stormwater Education Program Partners Meeting**

**February 26, 2025**

### **Minutes**

Nora Brown opened the meeting at 10:30am.

#### **I. Adjustments/changes to the agenda**

No adjustments to the agenda were made.

#### **II. Annual Report for 2024**

The annual report for 2024 was presented to partners, and no requests for modifications were made.

#### **III. Program Updates (past)**

Nora Brown provided updates on road salt best practices webinar hosted on February 12. She shared that about 20 community members attended, and the presentation by Kris Stepenuck of Lake Champlain Sea Grant was well-received.

#### **IV. Program updates (upcoming)**

Nora Brown reminded partners of upcoming programming, including two upcoming webinars on March 27 and April 23 and a rain barrel building workshop on April 13. Stream cleanups are planned for May and June, with firm dates TBD.

Bridget Butler asked to discuss expenses for the storytelling event planned for July 12. She shared that FNLC staff has been working to find music and food vendors for the event, and she wondered if the town might be able to help cover their fees. Specifically, they had booked a DJ who would charge \$375 for the event. Dave Allerton indicated that St. Albans town would likely be able to help cover this expense.

V. Other updates/comments

Dean Pierce shared that the program has a budget of \$1000 to cover expenses, which could be used to cover rain barrel materials and storytelling event expenses. He asked whether webinar presenters were being paid for their time. Nora Brown answered that they are not.

Nora Brown shared that she will be ordering rain barrel parts soon and estimates a total cost of around \$340.
